Our Rules

Positive Initiatives

Classroom Misconduct

In most cases teachers will use the following procedures:

- *Verbal warning*
- *Name on board*
- *Cross by name*
- *Time out (working in corridor or another classroom.) and / or*
- *Lunchtime detention (child will write a letter home explaining why he/she is on detention.)*
- *Reported to Principal*
- *Parents contacted.*

Where the safety of children or staff is at risk, or for repeated misconduct teachers may remove children from class immediately.

Serious Misconduct

- *Instant lunchtime detentions will be given to any student who bullies another student either in the classroom or in the playground or who deliberately damages school property. Parents/caregivers will be notified.*
- *When necessary Individual Behavioural Management Contracts for students will be implemented in consultation with parents/caregivers.*
- *Group Special education and/or R.T.L.B may be used to work with individuals.*
